Children Y4-7 are expected to wear the PE uniform, with track bottoms if outside. Y1 do not need a PE uniform. Y2 & 3 may purchase if they wish. Top & shorts: £14.50, navy socks £4. Available from Sportique.

Uniform reminder

Often at this time of the year, children need uniform items replaced (shoes, track bottoms etc). We would remind all parents (and children) that our uniform is black/navy shoes/trainers. Coloured trainers are to be kept for PE lessons. Track bottoms should be plain without any writing or logos. Girls often prefer to wear tights and skirts.

Jumpers. Please check that your child's name is still clearly visible on their jumper. We expect all children to wear their jumper/cardigan home as if they are wearing it, there is no chance they will leave it in school or mix it up with someone else! Jumpers with no names are kept at the back of the hall. Also as our school is well-heated, it is not necessary for your child to wear a 'skin' or undertop as they overheat in class and cannot easily take it off.

P7 PE uniform (when attending sports events outside school): PE t-shirt, shorts and plain navy bottoms. Y7 are out and about a lot during Term 2 & 3. We have new track tops for them to wear over their PE uniform for such events. However, it is important that they all have a PE t-shirt, shorts and plain navy bottoms. They will wear this a lot before the end of June (probably more than they have in Y5 & 6 altogether!), so even if your child has grown out of their old one, it is worth replacing.
