#### **Emergency Childcare provision for critical workers: COVID-19 Hub**

Critical workers are defined as parents whose work is critical to the COVID-19 response, including those who work in health and social care and in other key/critical sectors. However, many parents working in these critical sectors will be able to ensure their child is kept at home. The latest advice from DE & PHA is: Every child who can be safely cared for at home should be, to limit the chance of the virus spreading. The Department of Education has implemented a hub system for key workers who have no alternative childcare arrangements and should only be used in that circumstance. Staff from our school and other schools have volunteered (circumstances permitting) to work at the Hub School throughout this period. Magherafelt Primary School is now the Hub School for this area.
